'Mulsotan' is a documentary on the non-violent struggle of the Vasava tribal community in south Gujarat and their non-violent struggle for their land and forest rights spanning three decades. The film delves into the 32year-old struggle of the community.

A daily account of a very ordinary grandfather of a lower-middle class family in a suburban town - in the absence of the grandson.

Searcher

The artist begins an imaginative search into how she developed her schizophrenia, and wonders if trauma is passed down genetically through generations. She talks to the jamun tree in the courtyard and the tree replies in the voice of an old woman.





Submerged

(India, Other, 2023, 00:25:00) **Iqbal Hussain**

Kotmir, a village in the Dharaji Panchayat, was under the submergence area of the Omkareswar Dam built in the Narmada River. But many of the people from Kotmir had refused to leave the village due to unsettled compensation packages and they lived a subsistence life as migrant labourers in the cities.

Summer in Corbett

(India, English, 2022, 00:17:00) Swarnendu Biswas

How the forest dwellers in Jim Corbett National Park behave and survive during the summer is the main objective of this documentary. This is the oldest national park in India, established in 1936 in the foothills of the Himalaya covering over 520 sq. km area with about 600 species of flora, 50 species of mammals, 580 bird species and 25 reptiles.

Natthu Kaka waits for the rains every year hoping to find the wild mushrooms which spring out when the rains hit the ground. He finds them when he goes to graze his goats in the forests.
